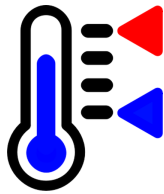

GETTING READY FOR SCHOOL

Parents & Guardians,
please go over
the following
steps AT HOME
every morning
before you leave
for school.



Please keep your child at home and seek medical care if he/she:

- Has a temperature of 100 or higher
- Displays cold or flu-like symptoms
- Complains of bodily aches and/or pains

Please call the office at 661-4720 to inform us that your child will be absent.

If your child is clear of this first step, please proceed to the next step...



Please check to make sure if your child will be wearing a face-covering to school. Your child is not required to wear a face-covering:

- If he/she is not able to wear a face-covering properly
- If he/she has a difficult time breathing with a face-covering.

Please inform someone at the check-in tent when you arrive at school.

Proceed to the next step...



Please remind your child about the importance of:

- Proper handwashing
- Use of hand sanitizer
- Keeping hands away from his/her face
- Keeping hands to him/herself

ARRIVING AT SCHOOL

Please go over these next steps if you are accompanying your child to school in the morning.



Sacred Hearts school believes that your child's health and safety are important, but we also want to make sure that your child feels safe and content. Please note the following:

- When necessary ONE parent or family member of the same household may accompany the child ON CAMPUS and see him/her off ONLY in the middle of the school courtyard.
- The ONE parent or family member of the same household must meet the first part of part one at home.
- The ONE parent or family member of the same household must wear a face mask at all times and refrain from loitering, congregating, and making contact with other adults.
- If you have seen your child off to class and would like to take care of business in the school office, you may line up to do so.
- Please plan ahead before leaving for school.



When you arrive at school a safety volunteer will check for the following:

- Your child's face-covering
- Your face-covering

We will continue with mid-day temperature checks like we did last year.

Once you and your child have been cleared, please proceed to the school entrance gate where someone will continue to direct you towards campus. Please see your child off in the middle of the school courtyard. Your child's teacher will be waiting to receive him/her. Please DO NOT enter the classroom hallways. You may return the way that you entered the campus.

SCHOOL PICK UP

Please go over these next steps if you are picking up your child from school in the afternoon



Each teacher and their class will wait together in a designated area on the church lawn. If your child has a cellphone, he/she may use it to receive your call for pick up. Once you have made contact with your child, he/she must inform his/her teacher that you are ready for pick up. Your child will then proceed to the crosswalk where the crossing guard will safely cross your child over to meet you at your vehicle. If your child is in Kindergarten or does not have a cellphone, you must meet the teacher for pick up.

Parents/Guardian and students must wear a mask or the appropriate face covering at all times during drop off and pick up.
