We ask that you please respect our guidelines for student drop off and pick up. **Drop-off and pick-up should only occur at our parking lot across the street and NOT in the MAUI JIM PARKING LOT.** There have been recent situations where clients of Maui Jim's are blocked by Sacred Hearts families waiting to pick up their children.
